DATA FOR BETTER DECISION-MAKING

Statistics Canada has up-dated its <u>Gender, Diversity</u> and <u>Inclusion Statistics (GDIS) Hub</u>, incorporating more diverse community data from across Canada. As part of the up-dates, the Hub now connects to <u>Sex, Gender, and Sexual Orientation Hub</u>, which will include data and analyses on gender and <u>LGBT2Q+</u> communities and will have the ability to filter data by population group.

The GDIS Hub now also serves as the platform for the <u>Disaggregated Data Action Plan</u> which will produce detailed statistical information to highlight the experience of specific population groups such as women, Indigenous peoples, racialized populations, and people living with disabilities.





COVID-19 Rapid Testing Program for Community Organizations

Nonprofits and charities in Ontario *may* be eligible to receive free Covid-19 Rapid Antigen Tests and support to implement an on-site screening program for your staff, volunteers, and the people you serve.

Offered by the Canadian Red Cross, and if approved, your organization will receive information and be matched with a Red Cross Program Officer.

Each month I will share some sources and resources selected to support your professional development and/or to address needs or issues your organization may be facing.

Imagine Canada has re-branded and re-launched the HR Council for Nonprofits as *HR Intervals*. Many organizations do not have dedicated staff or access to information to carry out HR functions effectively. **HRIntervals.ca** provides a free knowledge base and HR toolkits designed to support the nonprofit sector.

On January 20, Volunteer Halton hosted Benjamin Miller of Community Legal Education Ontario (CLEO) for a **Ontario's Not-For-Profit Corporation Act (ONCA) Transition Session**. The session was recorded and is now available on <u>Volunteer Halton's YouTube channel</u>.
