- critically assess current recruitment and screening processes with a view to enhancing the organization's ability to recruit an effective Board;
- design an orientation process that ensures Board members, current and incoming, have the knowledge they need to be effective around the Board table, and;
- understand the necessity for Board "orientation" to transform into year-round "capacity-building" processes to meet the demands of a constantly-shifting environment.

This workshop is intended for Board members and senior staff in nonprofit organizations and grassroots groups.
