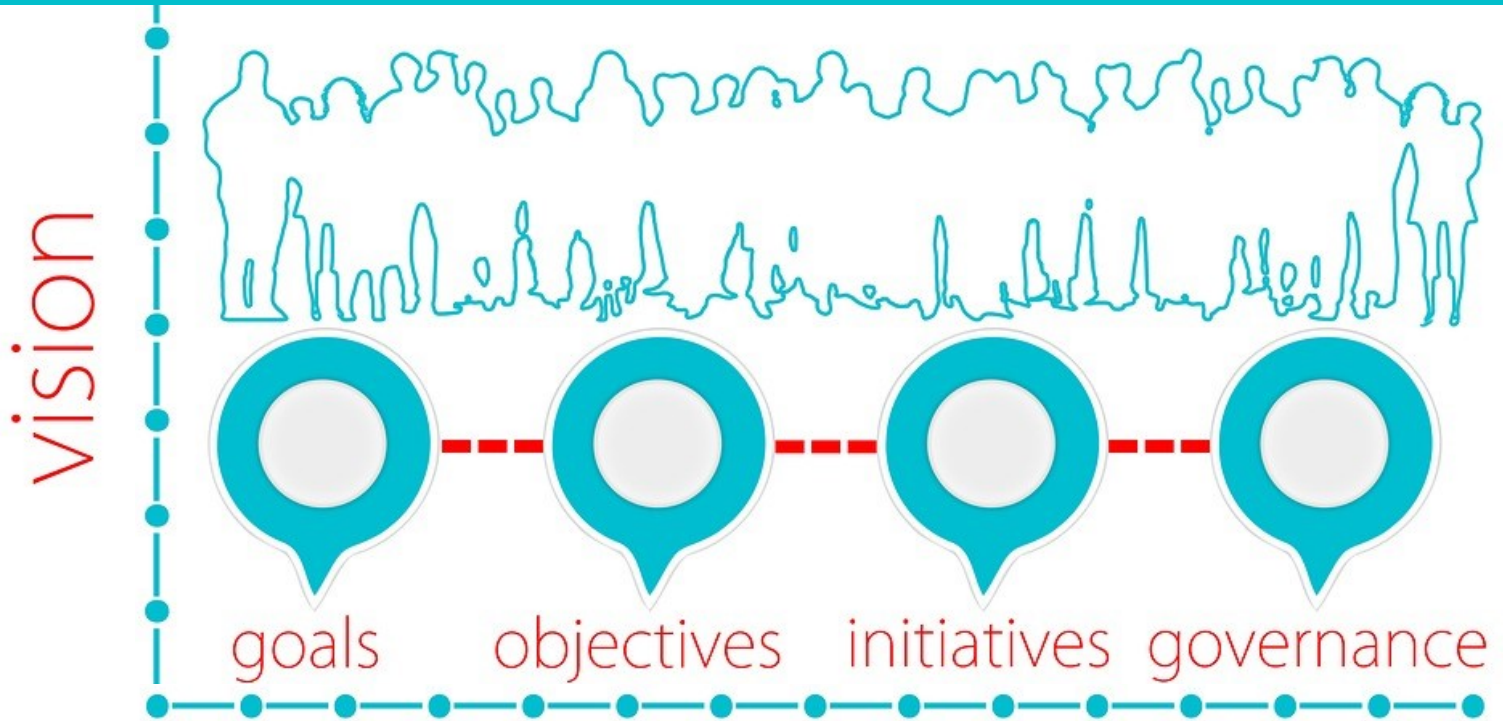


Governance 101



This session will provide an overview of the role, scope of responsibilities, and understanding of key elements shaping the effectiveness of Boards of Directors in the nonprofit sector. Focused particularly on people who are new or considering becoming a Board member, the session will also serve as a “refresher” for those with experience on Boards and senior staff who are charged with providing support to the Board.

Facilitator: JODY ORR, The Chrysalis Group, has an extensive background working in and with the nonprofit sector. She has a Master’s degree in Sociology and is a founding principal in an organizational and community development consulting firm. Jody worked for 17 years in the nonprofit sector and has since striking out on her own supported nonprofits, big and small, with a major emphasis on building capacity in a variety of areas, including effective governance.
