Strategic Focus at the Board Table



Boards of Directors have a critical responsibility for setting the strategic directions for their nonprofits, but too often end up focused on operations and micro-management of staff. While exercising good oversight of operations is critical, what steps can we take to help our Boards develop and maintain the strategic focus and good governance demands?

- Suggestions for using Board recruitment and orientation as tools in building the capacity for strategic thinking
- Concrete ideas for managing and structuring Board meetings that support strategic thinking
